

August 14, 2017 Minutes Of the Anderson Area Coin Club

Jerry Switzer opened the meeting at 7:03PM. Jerry described the new raffle (50-50) that will be started tonight to the membership. It will consist of picking the “Queen of Spades” out of a deck of cards. Jerry will be collecting dues and the monies for the Silver Eagle and “Queen of Spades” 50-50 raffles tonight.

Bruce Getman provided a discussion of the similarities of the French 2 Franc Walking woman and the USA Walking Liberty design. The French coin design may have been a starting point for the design of the US Walking Liberty Half Dollar. The history of the French designer and artistic influence that impacted the US designer was emphasized. Linda Rogers handed out a course and discussion of “Hidden Treasures”.

The Silver Eagle raffle and “Queen of Spades” 50-50 were conducted and a short break was taken. The auction was conducted by Bruce Getman and Gene Pruitt.
